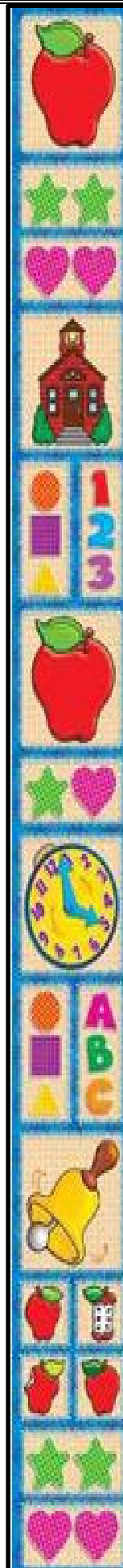

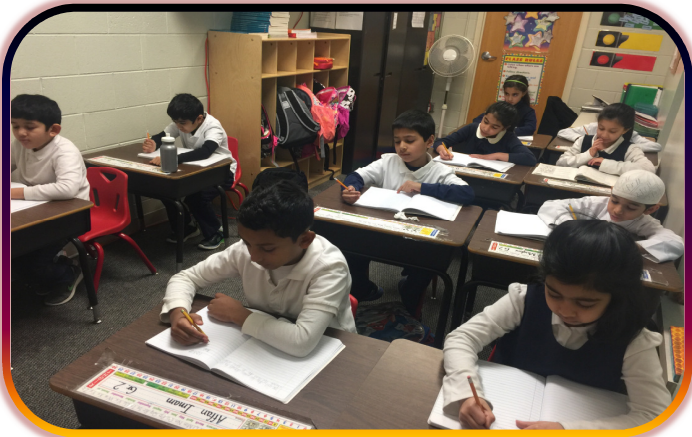
Classroom & Learning Moments
